

ACADÉMIE FRATELLINI OPENS A NEW CHAPTER IN ITS HISTORY

In keeping with its innovative and unique identity, in autumn 2021 Académie Fratellini began a major renovation and extension project for completion in 2024, to meet both its own need to innovate as a global centre of excellence for circus arts, and the needs generated by the rapid urban transformation under way in its area of Grand Paris.

Académie Fratellini has an artistic, cultural and social vocation. In 2024, it will provide a new community space where people from across Grand Paris can come together to meet, create and enjoy one another's company.

It will become an urban venue, blending into the city with its parvis combining a Main and a Small Square together with a wide thoroughfare running right through its Hall venue.

The project is part of the Bâtiments Durables Franciliens (sustainable buildings in Greater Paris) initiative. Académie Fratellini has strived since its creation to be sustainable and environment-conscious.

A HISTORIC VENUE PIONEERING THE MODERN CIRCUS


Académie Fratellini has stood on its site in La Plaine Saint-Denis, a stone's throw from the Stade de France, since 2003, carrying on the adventure begun forty years ago by Annie Fratellini and Pierre Etaix when they founded France's first circus school.

Its higher education centre now awards the degree-level advanced national professional diploma in circus arts, and its two auditoriums offer a regular programme of shows for a wide range of audiences.

One of La Plaine Saint-Denis' leading architectural sites, it was the first permanent circus venue built in France in the 21st century. It takes a pioneering approach to town planning and social cohesion.

Académie Fratellini also represents a full century of the cultural heritage of France, the Fratellini family and the revival of French circus. From the Fratellini Brothers trio in the 1930s to the creation of Europe's first national circus school to accept students from all backgrounds, opened by Annie Fratellini in 1973, it embodies the history of the Fratellinis, who set in motion a series of revolutions in what was previously a very closed artistic field.





THE BIG TOP


A breath-taking circular venue with a traditional vibe

This vast venue was built of reclaimed materials, with environmental excellence a focus from the start. The Big Top is fully equipped to meet the ambitious technical requirements of unique smart stage designs. The building is an awe-inspiring feat of architecture in that it was built without pillars offering the entire audience an excellent, unobstructed view of the stage.

Potential configurations: conventions, seminars, New Year's addresses, certificate presentation ceremonies, film sets and private shows.

CAPACITY: 1,500 PAX











THE LITTLE TOP

An intimate circular cabaret venue with a great atmosphere

This is the perfect warm and friendly venue. It connects directly with the outdoor spaces and can host up to 250 people. It is ideal for events focusing on communication between participants.

The Little Top opens onto the Small Square (see page 12). The two spaces can be combined together.

Potential configurations: seminars, meetings, break-out sessions, cocktail receptions, seated dinners, New Year's addresses and product presentations.

THE HALL

A warm, modular venue flooded with light

Thanks to its wooden roof structure seven metres high, this rectangular space with 1,100 sqm of floor space adapts to accommodate events of all types. The Hall runs right through the heart of Académie Fratellini, with the Main Square at one end and the Small Square at the other. This modular space is one of the site's key venues.

Potential configurations: cocktail receptions, seated dinners and cabaret dinners, New Year's addresses, forums, dinner dances, talks, product presentations, teambuilding events involving artists.

THE STUDIOS

Equipped for use by both professional and amateur sportspeople

The studios form the heart of the higher education college. They are the teaching venue for both the apprentice circus performers and amateurs of all ages.

They are equipped and fitted out for high-level sports training with mats and dance floors, aerial rigging and weight-training equipment. The studios are modular, with sliding doors for easy access. They can also be set up as rest areas or seated lecture theatres.

Potential configurations: sports training venue, rest and relaxation room, lecture theatre.



OUTDOOR AREAS

A lively new urban area is growing up around the Big Top and Little Top. Académie Fratellini's Hall has been designed to function as a thoroughfare running from the Small Square to the Main Square. The two open-air spaces also have sheltered areas.

They serve as extensions to the centre's key venues (the Hall, Big Top and Little Top). They have the potential to be used as welcome or reception areas, extending the venues and the potential they offer.

FLOOR AREA:

- MAIN SQUARE 900 M²
- SMALL SQUARE **590 M²**

- The entire site offers step-free access and meets all accessibility standards
- A private car park is available for event organisers
- The buildings and spaces have been awarded the High Environmental Quality label and renovated in line with a materials reuse and upcycling protocol
- Security services operate 24 hours a day

Académie Fratellini offers seated meeting and working venues for up to 50 people.

They are equipped with desks and all the equipment required to run a meeting (video projectors, flip charts and white boards) and also offer fibre optic internet connections.




BY CAR
